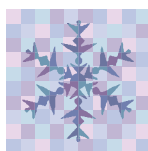
Diabetes and Peripheral Vascular Disease

Peripheral Vascular Disease (PVD) affects the blood vessels outside the heart and brain and is often associated with a narrowing of vessels that carry blood to leg and arm muscles. PVD is common among people with Diabetes, particularly women, who are nearly 8 times more likely to suffer from PVD than are women without diabetes. In fact, Diabetes is the most frequent cause of PVD. The relationship between Diabetes and PVD is due to diabetic complications that cause damage to the large and small blood vessels of the legs and feet.

All code assignments are based upon Physician's documentation. To insure proper documentation and reimbursement, the Physician must provide documentation in the medical record, the correlation between the PVD and Diabetes (Peripheral Vascular Disease due to Diabetes Mellitus). The information may not always be available in the current History and Physical, but previous medical records may have documentation that correlates the two diagnoses. "Winter Fun In The Sun"**

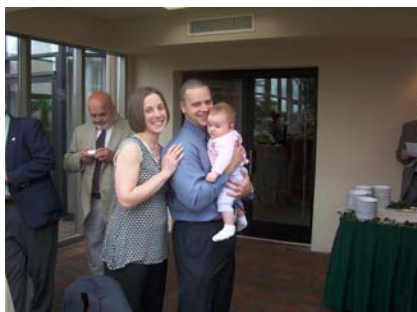
